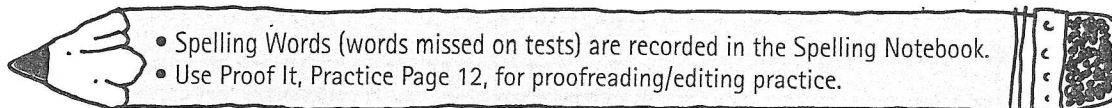

### BEFORE THE CLOZE STORY WORD TEST

Students do not prestudy the words. Provide students with a copy of REVIEW 4 BLACKLINE MASTER, page 40. Tell students that this is a story about a young lady who does not always use good sense.

Read the entire story aloud, including the test words. Then read it again slowly as students write the missing words.

### AFTER THE CLOZE STORY WORD TEST

1. Have students write and share their answer to the story question. Discuss Amelia Bedelia's interpretation of "sponge cake" and "dust the furniture." Then read *Amelia Bedelia* by Peggy Parish to see how Amelia interpreted the request to change the towels. Each of the Amelia Bedelia books in Parish's series uses humor to help students understand words with more than one meaning.
